



Contest Criteria and Guidelines

Schools across Saskatchewan do an amazing job recycling beverage containers, helping return 85% of the beverage containers sold in the province! You guys truly are heroes!

That's why we want to hear your story, in true Superhero fashion: a Comic Book!! That's right, we want you to make your very own comic book, tracking your journey from the beginning of the year all the way through to the end of the year where you officially gain SARCAN School Superhero status! Read the criteria and guidelines below and try follow them as closely as possible.

Guidelines and Format

Entries into the contest are accepted from October 15, 2019 to May 31, 2020.

If possible, include a mix of drawings (it is a comic book afterall!) and photos - visuals will bring your story to life! Try to hit as many of the topics offered in the guide.

Measurement

Your story must include the total number of refundable cartons you collected as well as the amount of funds raised. Please include the SARCAN location you worked with.

Creativity and Interesting Details

Explain how your school carton collection program was structured and explain any difficulties you had collecting and recycling cartons in your school. Explain how the money collected was used, and include any additional creative and unique aspects of your school's program.

Recycling Impact

Highlight the educational component and include detail such as the number of students involved, or any students that went above and beyond. Did your program involve any members of the community? Include any further details on how your program had an impact.
